The Town of Boscawen is inviting you to an Open House to discuss the future of the North Main Street/King Street Corridor. Please join us between the hours of 6 PM and 8 PM on Monday, November 14th at the Winthrop Carter House located at 215 King Street. You will have the opportunity to tour Winthrop Carter House while providing feedback on six topics related to the Corridor. Food will be served and there is no charge to attend this event.

Over the years, the Boscawen Planning Board has heard many comments through surveys and public feedback that the Corridor needs to be better defined and that traffic and safety issues need to be addressed. There is also interest in improving the appearance (landscaping and other design elements) along the Corridor, as well as protecting the historical resources. Acting on these concerns, the Board wants to hear from members of the community on what needs to be improved and ways to make the Corridor function more efficiently. Once there is a clearer understanding of the Corridor's role in serving the community, then the Planning Board can look at options to bring this vision to reality, including the consideration of any zoning changes that may be needed.

This Open House is one way for the Planning Board's to reach out to residents and business owners to discuss the issues, challenges, positives and negatives of the Corridor. Participants will be able to enjoy some light refreshments, and gather informally at the Winthrop Carter House where they will be able to participate in a discussion on six topics:

- Housing
- Transportation
- Economic Development
- Land Use
- Historic Preservation
- Design Standards
