Meeting was called to order at 6:25 PM

Updates:

The committee was warned about an IRS scam. There have been reports from some residents regarding phone calls claiming to be from the IRS and requesting money or personal information.

The DARE pancake breakfast was successful, as was the rabies clinic/dog registration that was recently held at the police station. The town registered 21 dogs and Riverside Vets vaccinated over 50 animals.

Other business:

Barbara Randall reported Police Committee minutes are now being published in the Boscawen News Vine. There was some concern that the final meeting minutes were being edited when published. She contacted Alan Hardy and attended the March 30th Select Board meeting to address this concern. Selectman Mark Varney reported the town's new website will start June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Lorrie Carey expressed concern regarding what the town is doing to engage teens in the community, specifically the 13 – 19 age group. Lt. Killary reported that currently there hasn't been much criminal activity involving that age group.

Kevin Sullivan reported that since unfortunately there wasn't enough interest in the Neighborhood Watch Program at this time, the program will not continue.
