## **Old Business:**

## Circle Roundabout Options for Review to present to the Select Board 09.10.20:

Chair Keegan discussed the options with the Committee. If any others come up, they can be discussed and brought forward to the Select Board.

Do no work on the Circle but continue fundraising: None were in favor of this option

Public Works to remove pile and place "Welcome to Boscawen" sign: None in favor of this option

Erect flagpole: Option 1 with additional items, see below.

Lay sod plant flowers: Sod/grass and plants will not survive the winter, no water or maintenance available. Money not well spent, extensive maintenance to establish into soil. None of the Committee recommends or agrees with grass or sod.

Complete the 3 12' stone walls: Bev Drouin will go back to stone mason and discuss a more inexpensive options. Granite will not be an option due to NHDOT, no breakaway.

Select Board ideas: Plan should meet the money on hand, stabilize the site and not have a partial project and complete by November 15, 2020. 2021 raise money for Step 2.

**Option 1**: If money is available for Flagpole, top soil, donation of bark mulch and bulbs/shrubs/winter plantings, Town of Boscawen Sign and incorporate the stone material, not relocate...

**Options 2**: Top soil, donation of bark mulch and bulbs/shrubs/winter plantings, Town of Boscawen Sign and incorporate the stone material, not relocate.

Town of Boscawen sign is a Welcome to Boscawen sign, the other two circle entrances are already in Boscawen. NHDOT approved this one specific sign, no other signs are an option.

## **Action Items:**

- Select Board Member Dickey to as the question of the SB to get a clear understanding of
  who can be contacted for fundraising and who cannot vs OHD committee. John is
  looking for guidance and leeway to navigate the directive. Places of potential funding are
  already on the OHD list. Needs a clearer picture.
- PCD Director Easler to contact Primex regarding liability of damage to Circle Roundabout
- Chair Keegan to contact Steve @ GMI for top soil
- Chair Keegan to talk with Lyman regarding the turn-around time for Rotary and designated \$ may be used for other items not just the flagpole by 09.10.20
- Chair Keegan to check with NHDOT regarding liability on circle
- Abbe to be in contact with Swyers with drawings for fundraising within two weeks
- Abbe to contact Colby Lumber for local bark mulch before 09.10.20
- Drouin to contact Wes Niebling regarding stone wall before 09.10.20

<u>New Business:</u> Discussion ensued regarding social media discussion, Boscawen Chatter. Much interest in rotary and inquiries. How to do outreach for leading discussions rather than the public initiating going forward for fundraising and keeping all updated.
