A motion was made to accept the 1/23/18 minutes. Seconded. All in favor.

Chief's Updates:

Mental health issues and accessing help for those in need are becoming more of a challenge for the department. Drugs continue to be an issue.

The department has had to deal with vehicles and ATVs riding on the rail trail. Officers also helped with storm damage on July 10<sup>th</sup> and a fire at Crete's Pallet business the following week.

The Chief is considering looking in to a new program, LEAD, to replace D.A.R.E. LEAD (Law Enforcement Against Drugs) is a more updated program that will still target 5<sup>th</sup> grade students at Boscawen Elementary.

The new cruiser is expected to arrive in August. At that time the Crown Vic will finally be retired.

New Business:

Both Lorrie Carey and Kevin Sullivan need to be reappointed to the Police Committee. The Chief will let the Select Board know at the next Select Board meeting.

With no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned to 6:45pm.
