To Whom It May Concern:

This is to notify the Town that the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) has developed a resurfacing project along US Route 4, beginning at a pavement joint at NH Route 11 in Andover and continuing easterly to a pavement joint at Water Street in Boscawen.

Work along this section of US Route 4 involves a 3/4" overlay and the replacement of guardrail sections as needed within the project limits. Traffic control will involve the use of one-lane, alternating two-way traffic, lane shifts, and shoulder closures where necessary to complete the work, supplemented with flaggers or uniformed officers with vehicles.

Throughout the duration of the project, and at the discretion of the Department, uniformed officers and flaggers will be used to control traffic. Portable changeable message signs will be used to notify motorists in advance of upcoming work and provide messages during construction. All work on this project will be performed such that traffic is unimpeded whenever possible.

This project is scheduled to advertise on October 2, 2018, however construction is not anticipated to begin until the spring of 2019 and be completed by the fall of 2019. A pre-construction meeting, to which the Town will be invited, will be held by the Contractor prior to the start of construction.

Included as part of this transmittal are two (2) copies of the Municipal Work Zone Agreement (MWZA) that all municipalities are asked to sign as an acknowledgement that the Department will have the authority to control traffic through the work zone for the duration of the project. Please sign both enclosed documents and return them to me in the self-addressed, stamped envelope provided. One signed copy will be returned to the Town and one retained in the Design file.

**MUNICIPAL WORK ZONE AGREEMENT  
FOR  
BOSCAWEN, NEW HAMPSHIRE**

**STATE PROJECT: STATEWIDE 41614  
FEDERAL PROJECT: X-A004(702)**

THIS AGREEMENT, executed in *duplicate*, made and entered into this 3rd day of October 2018, between the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the "DEPARTMENT" and the Town of Boscawen, hereinafter called the "TOWN."

WITNESSETH that,

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT will perform resurfacing activities along US Route 4 involving a 3/4" overlay and the replacement of guardrail sections as needed within the project limits;

WHEREAS, The State Legislature has delegated the Commissioner of the DEPARTMENT with full authority to control traffic in highway/bridge construction work zones on Class I, II, and III highways; RSA 228:21, 236:1, and 228:37;

WHEREAS, The Department intends to use a combination of flaggers and/or uniformed officers, as appropriate, to control traffic and ensure public and worker safety; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- A. The DEPARTMENT shall construct project STATEWIDE 41614, performing resurfacing activities involving a 3/4" overlay and the replacement of guardrail sections as needed within the project limits in the TOWN.
- B. The DEPARTMENT will be responsible for the management and operation of the highway throughout the duration of the construction of the project. This includes the authority to determine the most appropriate way to control traffic within the construction work zone limits of the project.
- C. The Department, as of April 1, 2013, will only compensate for the use of police officers that have successfully completed an NHDOT approved course on the Safe and Effective Use of Law Enforcement in Work Zones

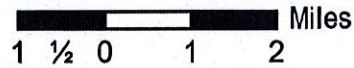
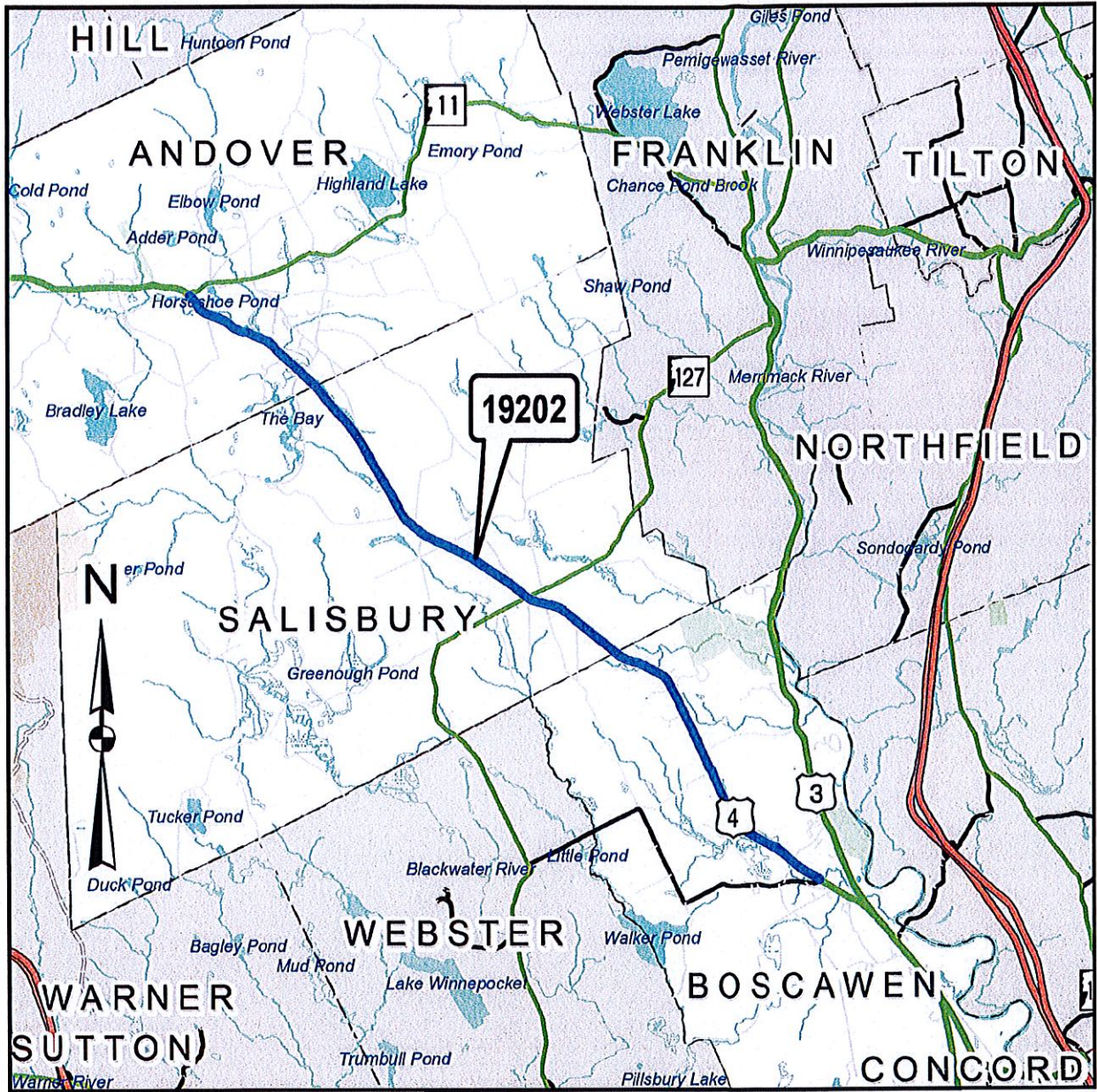
