



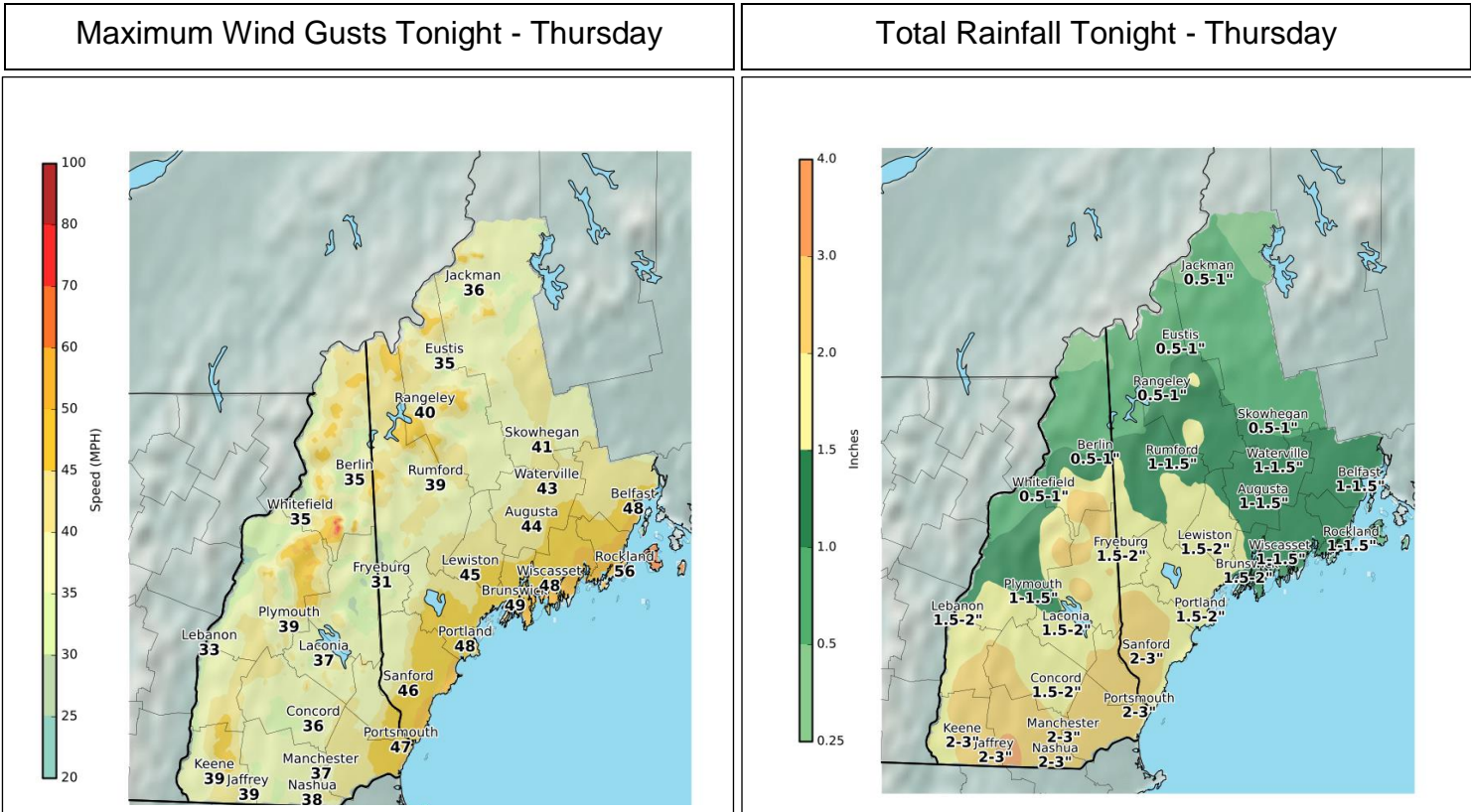

## Heavy Rain and Strong Winds Late Wednesday - Thursday



### Highlights/Key Messages

- Rain will move into the region late Wednesday and become locally heavy Wednesday night
  - Most locations will receive 1-2" of rain, with 3-4" in the highest locations.
  - Road flooding is possible particularly in locations where fallen leaves clog storm drains
  - Minor river flooding is possible.
- Wind gusts of 30-40 mph Wednesday night into Thursday morning, with gusts to 55 mph possible along the coast.

### Safety/Preparedness Tips for the Public

- ✓ Secure loose objects that may be tossed about in the wind.
- ✓ Prepare for possible power outages.
- ✓ Remove leaf litter from drains.
