

Heavy Rain from Henri's Remnants

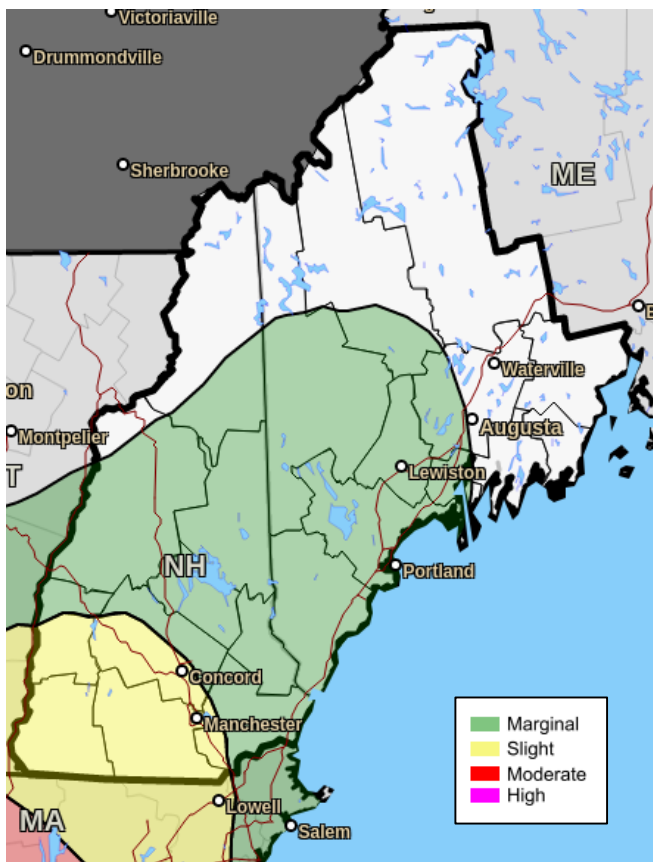

OVERVIEW

- Primary hazard is heavy rainfall leading to flash flooding. Greatest threat for flooding exists this afternoon and evening.
- Threat for gusty winds and coastal impacts wanes tonight into early Monday.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Henri's primary circulation dissipates to our west this morning. Showers, t'storms increase in coverage today as remnants return east. Drier air returns and showers taper off to the east on Tuesday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Very humid air means that any shower will be capable of producing heavy rainfall. Thunderstorms will contain heaviest rain with tropical rain rates. Reduced visibility persists with gusty showers through this evening. Slow-moving downpours may track through the same areas repeatedly tomorrow, leading to prolific rainfall and flash flooding. River flooding threat is currently low but cannot be ruled out entirely.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Forecast confidence in Henri's track is medium today and Tuesday.
