All 2024 **returning gardeners**, please submit your application and payment by April 1^{st} . If we have not received the application and payment by 4/1/24, your plot(s) may be assigned to another gardener.

If you are a new applicant and have not been assigned a plot, please do not send money until you have been assigned a plot. Submit your application now and you will be placed on a waiting list to be notified by the garden coordinator about plot availability and plot assignment.

Success at the Boscawen Community Garden depends on each of us. Our spirit of giving and growing is what makes our community garden standout. Volunteering is how we nurture & cultivate lasting friendships. It's always better in Boscawen!
