## **Notice of Decision**

At a regularly scheduled and duly noticed meeting of the Boscawen Planning Board on Tuesday, February 7, 2023 at 6:30pm, the Board approved an Application submitted by Building & Loan Development LLC, 23 Bush Hill Road Kinnelon, NJ 07405 with a location of Map 94 Lot 23, 477 High Street, Boscawen NH 03303, for a Major Subdivision, located in an AR zone, with the following conditions and findings of facts:

### Finding of Facts:

The application complies with the Town of Boscawen's Zoning Ordinance and Land Development Regulations given the plans presented and waivers granted.

#### **Conditions precedent:**

- 1. All State and Local Permits;
- 2. Conditions of approval and waivers to be shown on Mylar.

#### Conditions subsequent:

- 1. As-Built drawings;
- 2. If any preservation easements are discovered or required, construction must cease and the NH State Archaeologist must be notified;
- 3. NFPA-1 requirements for cisterns must be met for the 4-lot subdivision and a design must be stamped by a licensed Fire Protection Engineer before building permits can be issued;
- 4. Easement for future cistern to be approved by Town Counsel and paid for by applicant;
- 5. If a common driveway, as shown on 94/23/3 to access 94/23/2 is used, the easement should be recorded at the Merrimack County Registry of Deeds before the issuance of a driveway permit for either lot;
- 6. Impact Fees Apply.
