Resumé & Portfolio Development

Personalized review of your resumé or portfolio documents with recommendations for improvement. Our employment counselors will help you create a resumé if you do not have one.



Education & Training Connections

We help connect you with services to access community supports, earn credentials by furthering your education, and pursue training to obtain skills that lead to employment.



Work Readiness

We help prepare participants for the workforce through development of soft skills, interview preparation, and job search support.



Support Services

As a participant, you are entitled to reimbursements that are reasonable, necessary, and directly related to participation in the E&T program. Proper documentation is required.
