On November 22, 2022, at a duly noticed meeting of the Zoning Board of Adjustment, a Variance for a Boarding, Rooming and Lodging House in and IND zone located at 109 High Street, Boscawen NH 03303 on Map 81D, Lot 34 in an IND zone was *GRANTED*, by a vote of 4-1, for the reasons and conditions listed below:

Findings:

- 1. The variance is not contrary to the public interest;
- 2. The spirit of the ordinance is observed;
- 3. Substantial Justice is done;
- 4. The variance does not diminish the values of surrounding properties;
- **5.** Literal enforcement of the provisions of the ordinance would result in an unnecessary hardship.

Conditions:

- 1. Follows the Land Development Requirements for a Boarding, Rooming and Lodging House;
- 2. Parking to meet the requirements in the Land Development Regulations and Zoning Ordinance;
- 3. Site Plan to be updated to reflect changes to bedroom number;
- 4. Not to exceed 9 bedrooms;
- 5. Receipt of all State and local permits.
